Dear Lynne,

Thanks for this. I am all too aware of the pressures that schools in our area are under, and strongly believe that the time has come to end the sustained cuts that have effected schools and many other outside services which they work with in recent years.

I attended the schools debate on Monday, and although commitments elsewhere prevented me from making the speech that I had initially intended to give, I was still able to raise the issue of increased pension contributions through an intervention. I have also published an [article](#) on my website about this topic, outlining some of the problems that have been raised with me by yourselves and in the correspondence I have had with individual head teachers on this subject.

I am intending to raise these issues again next Monday, when Department for Education Questions are taking place in the House of Commons.

Thanks again for getting in touch with me and providing me with an invaluable insight into the pressure that schools in our area are currently under.
