Pupil Premium Grants

What you probably know already

There are different Pupil Premium Grants:

1. The Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) based on Free School Meals numbers. This is usually the largest PPG received.
2. PE Premium is specifically for development of fitness and healthy lifestyles. This is funded according to school size.
3. Early Years Pupil Premium is funded according to numbers of parents in receipt of key benefits and is aimed at Nursery aged children.

Pupil Premium Grants

The Pupil Premium Grant (PPG)

It is in a school's best interest to have children on Free School Meals (FSM) because all of these children's boost the money available to school for teaching etc. and school budgets are tight!

For Governors:

Your headteacher or finance officer should automatically tell you how much is received in Finance Committee meetings and it should be discussed when the budget is set.

Ask your headteacher how they are encouraging parents to be checked for FSM

What schemes or incentives have they tried to increase school dinner numbers?

Pupil Premium Grants

The Pupil Premium Grant (PPG)

Check your school website.

- How PPG has been spent over the last 12 months should be detailed on the school website together with value for money / impact information
- It is good practice to provide information about how the allocation for the current academic year will be spent. (This should have been determined during Finance Committee meetings already)

Your Headteacher should give Governors regular information about PPG spending and subsequent impact.

If they don't, then Governors should ask!

PE Pupil Premium Grant

PE Premium: Funded at a lump sum of £16,000 plus £10 per child from Y1-6

This increase was first seen last year and the "sugar tax" was commonly mentioned at the same time!

Pupil Premium Grants

The PE Premium

For Governors:
 Check your school website.
 How the PE premium has been spent over the last 12 months should be detailed along with the impact of these activities.
 It is good practice to provide information about how the allocation for the current academic year will be spent.

Difficult to measure
 difference as some don't
 PE anyway.
 How spent
 how intended spend.

Pupil Premium Grants

Early Years PPG is funded according to numbers of parents in receipt of key benefits and is aimed at Nursery aged children.

The funding is very small - £300 per child. Clearly this doesn't go very far.

Spending will nonetheless come under scrutiny with PPG.

Headteachers should be able to give a clear statement to Governors regarding how much is received, how it is spent and the impact.

small amount
 eg speech / language
 Not much accountability
 - balance money
 who to justify.

Greatest area of accountability

Clearly, PPG provides the greatest amount of additional money to school budgets.

Equally, schools and Governors have the greatest level accountability regarding spending and impact for this money

PPG and Governors

Questions to ask

- How did we spend our PPG / PE Premium / Early Years Pupil Premium last year?
- Did we spend it all?
- Was it spent appropriately? *that is app.*
- What was the impact?
- Where is the evidence?
- Is this on our website?

PPG and Governors: Questions to ask

- How are we spending it this year?
- How are we monitoring for impact?
- What did we learn from our spending and assessment of impact last year and what are we doing differently as a result? (Value for money)
- Are we adhering to our Pupil Premium Policy or PPG Strategy Statement?
